

Terms and Conditions

Applicable to parents registered with the CricketHero Program(s)

Payment

1. The Parent shall pay the whole agreed Fee to SyndiSportz prior to the Pupil commencing the cricket program.
2. The Fee is non-refundable under any circumstances whatsoever except with prior written agreement of SyndiSportz.
3. One full Months notice is required for any parents who wish to withdraw their child from the program, thereafter the parent will not be obliged to make any further payments.

Exclusion of liability

1. Whilst every care will be taken to ensure the safety of Pupils participating in our program(s), SyndiSportz, its coaches, servants, employees or agents accept no responsibility under any circumstances for any loss (consequential or otherwise), damage, expense, death or delay suffered/incurred by the Pupil/any other party arising directly or indirectly or in any way connected with the attendance of the Pupil during the Course (or any part of it) or any other act or omission on the part of SyndiSportz or any of its coaches, employees or agents even if such act or omission may seem negligent.
2. The Parent agrees (for and on behalf of the Pupil) that any claim by the Parent/Pupil against SyndiSportz or any coach, employee or agent of SyndiSportz must be brought within 60 days of the event that gave rise to such claim. Any claim made thereafter shall be time-barred.

General

1. In the event that SyndiSportz determines the behaviour of the Pupil to be unacceptable, SyndiSportz shall be entitled to exclude the Pupil from the program permanently or for such period as SyndiSportz shall (in its entire discretion) determine.
2. The standard of behaviour which is to be regarded as unacceptable during the Program or on Premises shall be determined by SyndiSportz.
3. SyndiSportz reserve the entitlement to the use of photographs and/or video recording that may be captured whilst participating in any of the program(s)
